Submission Guidelines

Thank you for considering The Cassidy Gallery At Jackson Village as a venue to sell your work. We currently represent 40+ artists from the Mount Washington Valley and New England, and work hard to make every one of our artists shine. Therefore, the artwork and fine craft we select must not directly compete with those of the artists in our gallery. We especially like work that is unusual or highly original, work that expresses the creative energy of The White Mountains.

Please read our list of guidelines below for submitting samples of your work. *PLEASE NOTE: Due to the high risk of computer viruses, we will not open any unsolicited e-mail with attached images. You may send attached images only after an invitation from us to do so.*

1. All artwork must be created by artists from New England. Sorry, no exceptions.
2. Our commission is 40%, and we require all of our artists to sign a one-year contract with us.
3. We are a for-profit gallery, therefore all submissions should be of professional quality, and sellable. Work created under the guidance of a teacher is not acceptable nor is 'hobby work'.
4. Send submission inquiries to: cassidygallery@earthlink.net. Use "ARTIST SUBMISSION" in the subject line. Please e-mail us a link to which we may view your work. If you have a website, include the URL. If your artist resume or CV is also online, please include the link where we can view or download it.
5. If you do not have a website, please let us know and we will ask you to email samples of your work to us.
6. If you prefer to send us a packet with slides or reprints, you must include a stamped, self-address envelope for its return. We will not return packets without the SASE. Packets should be sent by US Mail to: *Cassidy Gallery, PO Box 1712, Conway, NH 03818*. Do NOT mail packets to our physical location because we do not have US Mail delivery at the Gallery (FedEx, UPS only).
7. The work you choose to show us should be your very best work and photographed clearly so we can see the detail. Please do not show work that is weak nor send us photos with vignettes (a fuzzy frame around the photo). For 2D artists, we also would like to see one or two examples of your framed work. Framed artwork should be professionally done.

If your work does not make the cut, please don't get discouraged! The professionalism in the work of our artists takes a long time to achieve, with years of college, courses, trials and errors behind them. Continue to work and learn, and come back to us for another review if you feel your work has improved.
